# Sea Creature Hats





## You will need

- Paper plates or card cut into circles - use cereal boxes and draw around a plate to get your circle
- Coloured card or paper
- Card cut into strips to make one long piece- to fit around your head.
- Scissors,
- Stapler, sellotape or glue
- Colouring things - paints if you have them or use coloured pencils or pens

1. Decorate your circles with different patterns – try fishy shapes, spots and wiggly lines, then leave them to dry.





3 – Make your headband. It should fit snugly just above your ears.

4 – Make your creature's head. Fold one circle in half - this will be the main head piece. Use another circle to make eyes and fins - make them all fishy - look at the images and create your own version

5. Staple, tape or glue these to your headband. Try it on at this point to check whether you can see!





6. Cut the rest of the circles into quarters, and then into shapes – these could be like tentacles, or seaweed – use your imagination, the crazier, the better

7. Stick these onto your hat, behind the head.
